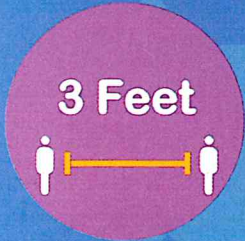
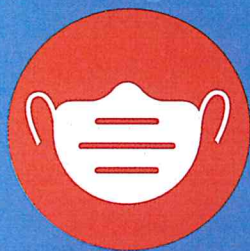

## 2021-2022 COVID HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES



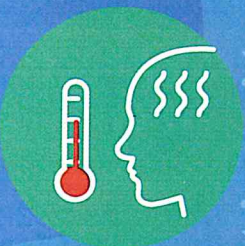
Continue to maintain social distancing in all school settings as much as possible.



Properly fitted masks are RECOMMENDED



Buses and buildings will be properly cleaned and regularly sanitized.



Any school campus with **3** or more confirmed positive cases will immediately return to fully required masking guidelines for a minimum of 10 calendar days (including transportation & extracurricular activities)

-Employees & Students (Pre K-12) who are directly exposed will isolate at home for **10** calendar days as per guidelines related to onset of symptoms

-If isolation totals per campus reach 18%-25%, the students will go into full remote learning at home for a minimum of **10** calendar days. Teachers not isolated due to Covid-19 will work from the school campus

-\*Overall health conditions and/or additional guidance or requirements may change these guidelines at any time

### REMEMBER

Hygiene measures, physical distancing, good hand-washing practices, and symptom monitoring are still very strongly encouraged and necessary to maintain a lower risk of infection.
